Sir Ashton had no children. His younger brother, Rev. John Lever's great granddaughter Elizabeth, married Rev. Michael Henry Simpson who would have been my great grandfather.

There were 14 in Michael Henry's family, five boys and nine girls. All but one lived into older years. His son, Sydney Seymour, came to Canada about 1883 and remained here.

Francis Lever went to India and died there.

Two daughters also lived for some time in Canada. Ellen Gertrude married to Rev. Michael Maude, lived in Manitoba and Lucy Claudine married to William Murray also lived in Canada, New Brunswick. Alice Mabel married to William Henry Pickering, lived in Calcutta for an unknown length of time.

Sydney Seymour had six children, three boys and three girls. One son died in infancy and Sidney died in 1950. The third son, George Harold has one son - Clifford John.

Clifford John has one son - Bryan Murray.
